**MAJOR DUTIES:** The primary purpose of this position is to serve as an Engineering Technician in support of the Execution Support mission to include providing Computer-Aided Drafting (CAD) capabilities in support of design and construction for the installation and Geographically Separated Units (GSUs). Produces mapping products utilizing Geographic Information Systems (GIS) tools, applications, programs and related practices and technologies. Completes related tasks in order to assist, sustain and operate Geographic Information Systems (GIS) in support of the Geobase Program. Maintains engineering drawing records for the installation, verifies accuracy of “as-builts” prior to acceptance. Performs related duties in support of planning, operations, design, construction and deployment of personnel on the installation and Higher Headquarters. Develops, produces and helps maintain maps and mapping products. Utilizes Geographic Information System (GIS) software to create, update, produce maps and package data in support of Installation and Higher Headquarters’ requirements. Assists in producing and maintaining Base Comprehensive Plan (BCP) map information (drawings, prints, etc.) and other Mission Data Sets (MDS) in support of the installation in compliance with Air Force standards and local guidance. May require site investigations to verify existing conditions and to ensure all features are reflected accurately on completed maps and databases. Develops and produces drawings utilizing computer aided drafting software. Accomplishes drafting duties with computer software in support of Civil Engineer personnel to develop and produce drawing files from ideas, sketches, calculations and specifications into finished construction drawings. Implements Architectural, Engineering and Construction (AEC) standards along with all Air Force and local guidance. May require site investigations to verify existing conditions and to ensure all features are reflected accurately on completed drawings. As needed, accomplishes surveying tasks to include location and topographic work. Operates large format printers, scanners and various industry equipment for assigned duties. Utilizes various pieces of industry equipment to accomplish daily assigned duties, to include producing maps, drawings and visual aids. Equipment used includes large format printers, scanning devices, cameras and various items related to duties and responsibilities. Maintains hard copy and digital record drawing files. Revises completed

drawings to reflect "As-Built" conditions. Systematically files original drawings and maps following established procedures. Maintains copies of all as-builts and new designs on computer storage media. Repairs and/or replaces tattered and worn drawings by mending, tracing, re-drawing or by reprographic means.
